

Walkthrough for One Ring

ONE RING TO RULE THEM ALL, ONE RING TO BIND THEM,

You are given I, R and M. N has to be adjacent to I (RING) and has to be no more than 2 squares from M (THEM and ONE) so must be in the 3rd column, B3 or D3. However N has to be next to O, E (ONE), I, G (RING) and D (BIND), and there is not room for this on D3 so

B3 is N

E has to be by M (THEM) and N (ONE) so

C4 is E

ONE RING TO BRING THEM ALL AND IN THE DARKNESS BIND THEM

Now N has to be by O, E, I, G, D, A (AND) and K (DARKNESS). N also has R by it so this accounts for all the squares by it and the remaining squares by N are O, G, D, A, K

L has to be by U, which is by R (RULE), and L also has to be by A (ALL), which is by N, so

D4 is U, C5 is L and B4 is A

E has to be by H, which is by T (THEM) so

B5 is H and A5 is T

From TO

A4 is O

From DARKNESS

A3 is D and B2 is K and D3 is S

From BRING

A2 is G and D2 is B

And from FIND

D1 is F
